Abstract guidelines

- * Abstracts should be submitted with the format: Title, Authors, Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- * The body of the abstract should have no more than 250 words
- * Tables, figures and references not included in the word count
- * Please email abstract submissions in a Microsoft Word document no later than June 5th to wassubmissions2023@gmail.com
- * Accepted abstracts will be expected to be presented as a physical poster with or without associated oral presentation at the WAS seminar on 10th July 2023.
- * The prize-winning poster will be invited to give a brief 5 or 10-minute oral presentation of their work during the final session. The prize will be awarded based on the scientific merit and quality of the presentation by a panel of judges appointed by WAS.
- * The top three posters will feature on our website. Submitting your work entails permission for us to display the poster on our website.
- * Abstract acceptance is dependent on at least one co-author attending the conference in person.
- * Authors will be informed of acceptance within four weeks of submission. Please only consider your work submitted once you have received acknowledgment of receipt from WAS.
- * Only original posters that have not been published or displayed at other events will be considered. Medical students are welcome to submit! Medical student non original work will be considered for presentation, but only original work will be considered for prizes.

Poster Guidelines

*If accepted for oral presentation only one author will be able to present, although we acknowledge the contributions of all authors.

*Previously published work, or work presented elsewhere is not eligible for submission.

*Posters may be in portrait or landscape, so long as they are size A1 (594 x 841mm)

*The presenting author may be asked questions about their work, so are encouraged to be accessible to their poster during periods where delegates will be viewing their work.

*All contributing authors, and affiliations must be acknowledged.

*Posters should have a logical structure, utilise images, tables and avoid long prose wherever possible.

*All work must be referenced using the Vancouver system (numerical)

*Where case studies, trials, or patient information is included, all appropriate consent or ethical approval must be demonstrated.

*All funding must be acknowledged.
